

The Life of Galileo Galilei



Galileo Galilei was an Italian university teacher. He also was an philosopher, physicist, mathematician, engineer, astronomer and cosmologist. Many of his discoveries especially in the mechanics and astronomy are considered ground breaking. He was born on the 15th February 1564 in Italy, in the city Pisa. And he died on the 8th January 1642. in Italy, in the city Arcetri. And he lived in Pisa and the grand duchy of Tuscany. He had three kids named Virginia Galilei also named Maria Celeste, Livia Galilei and Vincenzo Gamba. And his girlfriend that he was never married to was named Marina Gamba. Galileo went to a university in Pisa. In 1/7/1610 he discovered three moons of Jupiter, shortly afterwards the fourth. They are called the "Galilean moons." Galileo Galilei was one of the first to study astronomy and discovered that the earth revolved around the sun. He also wrote four books. The names of the books were Sidereus Nuncius or also called the Sidereal Messenger, Dialogo sopra i due massimi sistemi del mondo, Discoveries and Opinions of Galileo, Dialogues Concerning Two New Sciences and The Essential Galileo.
