Leonardo Da Vinci was born in Anchiano in Italy on 14 April 1452. He died in Amboise in France in 1519. His parents were Piero da Vinci and Magd Caterina and he had 17 half-siblings. Leonardo da Vinci was an Italian painter, sculptor, architect, anatomist, mechanic, engineer and natural philosopher. He is probably the most popular painter of all time. His best-known pictures are: The Supper (1498), Lady with the Hermelin (1489), Salvator Mundi (1500), Ginevra de' Benci (1478) and above all the Vitruvian man from his diary. But his best and probably best-known picture is the Mona Lisa. Leonardo took the Mona Lisa almost 10 years to really finish painting. Now the Mona Lisa hangs in France in Paris in the Louvre and has a value of 843 million.
